**Little Gasparilla Island Fire and Rescue (LGIFR) (The LGPOA is not affiliated with the LGIFR, we just want to keep you up to date on all island activities.)

From Fire Chief, Bill Underhill:

We are under a state issued burn ban. This means no fires at all, for any reason. This burn ban includes fire pits, rings, holes and barrels. The only acceptable fire is a barbeque grill.

As the island opens back up to the public be courteous to people. If you are not comfortable around them, keep your distance. Having spoken to police enforcement "bullying" of any owner or renter coming to the island will not be tolerated.
