With the recent electrical issues, FPL has determined there is a faulty feed underground at the Hide Away Condos. They made route changes to get power working for everyone and will be deciding what to do and when to make the repair.

We have owners and renters returning to the island. As we enjoy our time here, please keep a few things in mind:

- 1. **Water Safety**. We are getting reports of RIP current conditions frequently, and with the recent weather there have been more obstacles exposed both in the water and on the beach.
- 2. **Golf Carts**. Check your batteries and connections, if something does not look or smell normal call the golf cart shop or the fire station.
- 3. **Boats**. For those of you with boats, keep a check on your bilge pumps and all drain plugs, a failure with either of these is a serious problem.
